I. God Has Given Men Over To The Impure Lusts Of Their Hearts (vv. 24-25)

II. God Has Given Men Over To The Degrading Passions Of Their Flesh (vv. 26-27)

III. God Has Given Men Over To The _____ Of Their _____ (vv. 28-32)
