Omnipresence = God is **always present**, everywhere at once.

Jer 23:23-24, John 4:24

Point 1:

We should never allow the **greatness of God** to overshadow the reality of His presence,

Because the beauty of His greatness **is magnified** by the reality of His presence.

Point 2:

God is not omnipresent to **passively observe**, but to be **actively involved** in every aspect of creation.

- a. God is **Immanent**, meaning He is **intimately involved** with all that He created.
- b. God's omnipresence reaches beyond sustaining the universe and into the most **minute details** of our everyday lives

Col 1:15-17

Point 3:

God's omnipresence reaches beyond sustaining the universe and into the most **minute details** of our everyday lives.

- a. God is omnipresent to **pursue relationship** with us, and to give us the **opportunity** to pursue relationship with Him.

What about the times when God seems distant?

Point 4:

In seasons when God seems far away, we must press into **the promise** of His presence all the more.
